Send Official High School Transcript (all freshmen and transfer students with fewer than 24 credits). Non-English transcripts require an official English translation accompanied by original transcript.

Send Official College Transcript (transfer students only). Required from ALL previous colleges or universities. Non-English transcripts require an official English translation accompanied by original transcript.

Request Test Scores: Have scores from one of the following sent directly from the testing agency. Transfer applicants who have earned 24 or more credits from a U.S.-based college (a college English class must be one of the classes) are not required to submit a score.
